Comte de Grasse Distillery lies in the town of Grasse, where perfume masters have been extracting and blending flavours for centuries and where the master distiller was inspired to create the first 100% French Vodka Rosé. Using AWX, the group's trademark low-temperature and low-pressure extraction method, all flavors are extracted without missing out through a concentration process that condenses flavor molecules. A 28% infusion of rosé creates the perfect balance of rosé molecules and vodka.

Tasting Note

The nose is all elegance and concentrated freshness with light wafts of strawberries. The palate is a discovery, delicate floral notes with white peaches and a soft fruity finish. All reminiscent of a Provençal breeze.

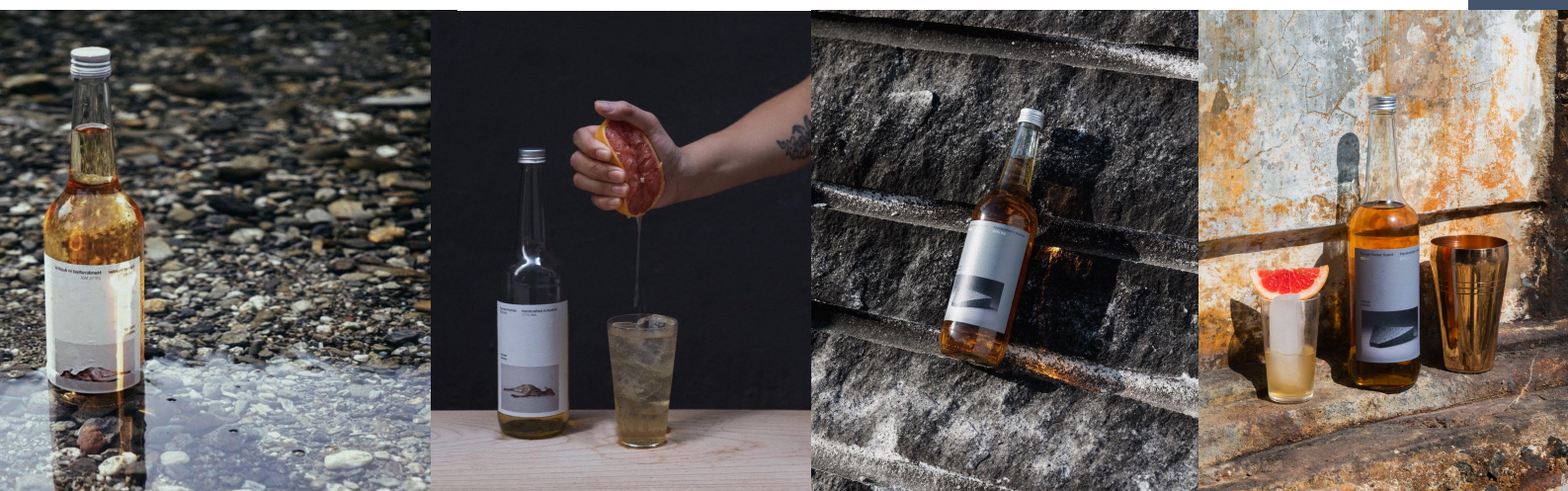

Fernet Hunter, created by friends Raphael Holzer and Neville Kotewall in Hong Kong, reflects their shared passion for quality food and drink. Despite diverse backgrounds, they both value craftsmanship and artisanal products in the realm of food and beverage culture. Raphael's family history, rooted in alcohol production, traces back to his great-grandfather Oskar Holzer, who played a pivotal role in Fernet Stock's introduction in Trieste, Italy, and later contributed to the Stock empire's growth, even relocating during World War II. Guido Holzer, Oskar's son, excelled as a distiller at Stock, leading to the establishment of Holzer & Holzer in the late 1960s. Gilbert Holzer, Guido's son, continued the family tradition of distilling in the Brunnwald Forest, where Raphael grew up and developed his passion for the spirit industry, and where Fernet Hunter is currently produced.

Handpicked during the hunting season and infused with a low-temperature method, these ingredients contribute to Fernet Hunter's distinctive character and balance. Perfect for Highballs or Shaken Cocktails.

Tasting Note

Delicate floral notes blend with citrus and complex spiced aromas. The taste journey begins with bittersweet tones, shifts to warm herbal and floral notes, and concludes with sweet herbal, bark, and pleasant bitterness.

Fernet Hunter Granit

The 2nd-generation iteration, is a collaboration by father and son, Holzer/Holzer. Notable for heightened dryness, increased bitter notes, and less sugar than the original, it introduces Chamomile for added aromatic complexity alongside Arnica, Orrisroot, and Lavender. Named after the granite rocks in Austria's Mühlviertel region, it embodies the essence of granite through a tweaked recipe emphasizing roots, and subtle lavender and arnica aromas. Ideal for Highballs or Stirred Cocktails.

Tasting Note

Woody, earthy dry notes with aromatic herbs and floral undertones lead to initial dry bitterness, transitioning into warm spice and herbal flavors, ending with mild spice and herbal bitterness.

Bernhard Ott's nickname is "Mr. Veltliner". This title describes his dedication to Austria's hallmark variety. Since the year 2000, 90% of his vineyards are planted with Grüner Veltliner. The deep loess soils of his home in the Wagram Region provide perfect conditions for this variety to express the uniqueness of this extraordinary terroir.


Since Bernhard took over responsibility for the winery in 1995, the name Ott has become a synonym for freshness and purity of fruit as well as drinkability paired with volume and substance. His intense desire to produce something unique and preserve the singularity which nature provides his wines has inspired him to shift to biodynamic cultivation of his 45 hectares.

Bernhard Ott is distinguished by the magazine Falstaff as "Vintner of the year 2008".

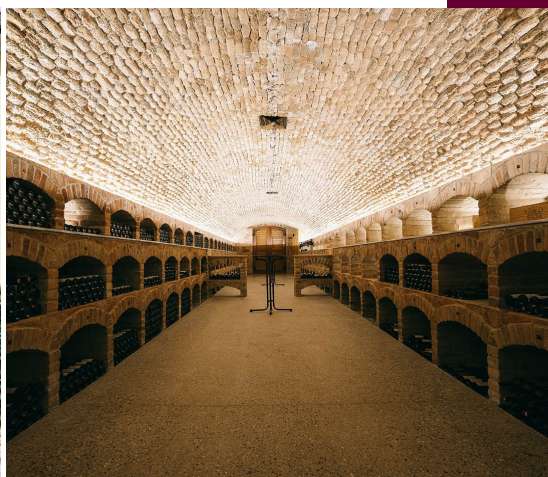
Tasting Note
